The Schools & Libraries Bandwidth Assessment Tool and the Broadband Demand Portal make up the **Schools & Libraries Broadband Marketplace**. These tools support the FCC's E-rate program for both E-rate participants and broadband providers.

Cooperative Development

At the encouragement of the FCC, CQA, working with the Wisconsin Broadband Office at the Public Service Commission, partnered with the non-profit group Education SuperHighway, to develop a set of tools to assist E-rate participants to accurately interpret their bandwidth needs prior to submitting their FCC Form 470. Wisconsin became the BETA launch site and the tool was officially launched in March 2017.

Bandwidth needs are assessed based on demand and usage for:

- Video
- Voice
- Audio
- Administrative Tools
- Data /Smartphone/ Tablets

Our web-based applications were developed to support the E-rate program in two ways:

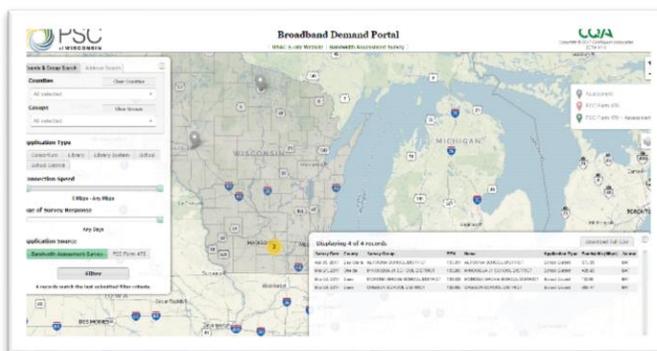
The Schools and Libraries Bandwidth Assessment Tool helps you understand your bandwidth needs through a three-phase approach:

The Broadband Demand Portal unites demand with supply by allowing ISPs to identify organizations across the state who have either taken a Bandwidth Assessment or applied for E-rate funding.



Portal features include:

- Convenient filtering options.
- Map markers to display Form 470 and assessments.
- A tabular results table allows for downloading participant information.
